#### The Goal of the Data and Assessment Task Force

To create a district-wide assessment calendar (K-12) for the purpose of collecting data to inform instruction throughout the year. There are two calendars: (1) Mathematics, and (2) English Language Arts.

Both calendars are divided into four columns:

• Date: The month in which the assessment will be administered.

Assessment: The name or type of assessment to be given.

• Who: The student population to be tested.

• Purpose: The purpose of the assessment.

#### **Common Understandings for Educators**

- District educators will follow the assessment schedule outlined by the Data & Assessment Task Force.
- Classroom and special educators will maintain assessment data via the data entry listed on the MSD Assessment Schedule.
- Assessment administration guideline dates will be maintained unless modified by administration, department heads, coordinators and/or facilitators.
- Data from universal and diagnostic screenings, as well as formative assessments will be analyzed by educators to inform instruction.
- After a review of multiple data points, students who fall below benchmark will be considered for Tier 2 or 3 interventions, and likewise, students who score significantly above benchmark will be considered for extension opportunities.

A **Universal Screening** is an assessment given to students in a group or grade level. The purpose of this assessment is to identify any students who are significantly below the benchmark and may need intervention, or to identify students significantly above the benchmark who may need enrichment.

A **Diagnostic Screening** is a pre-test to collect data about what a student knows and does not know yet.

**Formative Assessment** refers to a wide variety of methods that teachers use to conduct in-process evaluations of student comprehension, learning needs, and academic progress during a lesson, unit, or course (retrieved from *edgolssary.org*).

\* Though both diagnostic assessments and formative assessments aim to inform teachers to instruct more effectively, they emphasize different aspects. Formative assessments are taken during a unit to assess how students are learning the material that the teacher has been teaching. Diagnostic assessments come before this, analyzing what students have learned in the past, many times from different teachers or classes. Both are very helpful for the teacher, and the results are used to identify areas that need more attention in future instruction. (Retrieved from https://edulastic.com/blog/diagnostic-assessment/).

**Summative Assessments** are used to evaluate student learning, skill acquisition, and academic achievement at the conclusion of a defined instructional period (retrieved from *edgolssary.org*).
