81% of faculty have earned a Master's Degree or higher (MA, MA+15, MA+30 and PhD)

From March 2020 until June 2020, MHS students were fully remote. While grades were assigned, that semester was not included in GPA calculations.

During the 2020-2021 school year, MHS employed a hybrid or fully remote option for students. Students in the hybrid cohort attended school two consecutive days each week while remote students attended in person virtual instruction two consecutive days each week. *MHS did pivot to full remote for all students from Thanksgiving until MLK Jr. Day.

Graduation Requirements

All students must earn a minimum of 21 credits in order to graduate.
