

PROMOTION AND RETENTION OF STUDENTS

Students shall be promoted to, or retained in, the appropriate grade level. Students are promoted to the next grade level each year unless a decision is made otherwise. This decision is made jointly by the school principal or designee, school counselor, teachers, and parents/legal guardians with the school administrator moderating any disagreements and making the final decision.

Criteria to be considered regarding the promotion of students should include, but is not limited to, a student's mastery of course level competencies, grades, teacher recommendations, and the student's social growth and readiness, and the district's academic standards as approved consistent with RSA 192-E:2-a,IV.

The Superintendent or designee and building principals shall develop rules and/or procedures for the promotion and retention of students. These rules and/or procedures will be approved by the Board and shall be published in the Parent-Student Handbook for each school.
