HAS YOUR CHILD BEEN DISMISSED DUE TO UNEXPLAINED SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19??

This is the protocol for when they can return to school:

Option #1: Stay home from school for 10 days...the last 24 hours must be fever free and symptom free without the aid of medications...if they are still having symptoms or fever, continue to stay out until they can be symptom and fever free for 24 hours.

Option #2: Have a COVID-19 test

*If negative, student may return to school once they have not had a fever X 24 hours (without medicine) and their symptoms are improving. School must have documentation of negative testing before return and then School Nurse will reach out to you with directions for return.

*If positive, contact School Nurse at 424-6221. Student needs to stay out of school for 10 days from day of test, with the last 24 hours being fever and symptom free without the use of medications. Public Health Department will be in contact with both you and the school to conduct contact tracing for potential exposure to others.

**If you have to be out of school for any time, please contact the front office for direction for continued learning.
