

Parent/Guardian Covid-19 Screening Checklist - Merrimack School District

Every morning before you send your child to school, please check the following:

1. Does your child have a fever greater than 100 degrees and/or is experiencing any signs of illness* such as:



Fever 100 or chills



Cough
(especially new onset,
uncontrolled cough)



Shortness of Breath or
Difficulty Breathing



New Loss of Taste
or Smell



Congestion or
Runny Nose



Diarrhea, Vomiting,
Nausea, or Abdominal Pain



Muscle or Body
Aches or Fatigue



Headache
(particularly new onset
or severe headache)



Sore Throat

2. Was your child in close contact (within 6 feet for more than 10 minutes) with anyone confirmed with COVID-19 within the last two weeks?

If the answer is YES to any of the questions DO NOT send your student to school. Stay home and contact your healthcare provider.

*Please note any student that develops any of the above symptoms during the school day will have a parent/guardian contacted immediately and will be dismissed with instructions to follow up with a healthcare provider.

*If your student has a medical condition that may mimic symptoms of COVID-19 please work with your healthcare provider to obtain documentation for the school health office.
