THE PROGRAM - Public kindergarten is available to any Merrimack child who will be five years old by September 30, 2021 for the 2021/2022 school year. The day includes a variety of activities designed to promote individual growth and to establish strong academic and social skills for all children. A typical day includes learning centers, circle time, free choice, unified arts, recess, lunch, and snack time.

The kindergarten program is aligned with the district's elementary curriculum.
