Final Preparation Suggestions:

- Practice in front of an audience (parent, sibling, friend) the more the better!
- Stand (yes, stand!) tall!
- Practice running your piece through start to finish mistakes and all. Do this regularly starting today! Then, work on cleaning up specific spots.
- Make eye contact with the adjudicator (judge), smile, and say, "hello!"
- You may be asked if you want to scales or your piece first (think about this).
- You may be asked to choose a scale to play (so think about this, too).
- Pause and breath before playing any/everything! Think before jumping into a scale, breath (slowly!) before beginning your piece...
- If you make a mistake (mistakes!) don't fret! Keep going, or pause and back up a couple of measures. Practice this. And you don't need to apologize everyone makes mistakes!
- Be proud of yourself! You've taken on a challenge and you've worked hard! Be proud of the strong character you are building and for being a better player today than you were before you started this process:) Go Merrimack Music!
