We wanted to make you aware of a new tool being utilized by the district called **Performance Matters**, which brings together student performance data needs in one easy to use online portal. Parents can now go into the Parent Portal to view local and state assessment results. Please be aware the email address used for the PM Parent Portal is the same email used in your linked PowerSchool account. If you do not have an established PowerSchool account, you will not be able to access the Performance Matters Parent Portal. For assistance with creating a **PowerSchool** account, you may contact your school's main office.

After you log in, you will see some basic student information at the top. For testing information, you can click on these tabs:

- The "**State Results**" tab displays state data as well as reporting categories. It displays all historical state data available in the platform. You can also click on the "Show all scores" box to see the results in more detail.
- In the "Observational Results" tab, you may see some additional Common Core screeners.
- In the "Additional Results" tab, you will find all other results for assessments given. You can also filter these out by the year, as well as the measure. For example, this is where you can see the results for **i-Ready**.
