

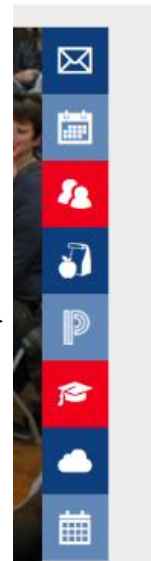
EnVision Math Resources

Through EnVision Math, students and parents may log into Pearson Realize in PowerSchool to view student resources. Students and parents may log into EnVision Math Realize at:

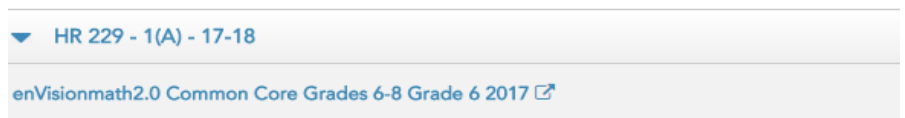
