What is Junior First Lego League?

- A hands-on program designed to capture you child's curiosity and direct it toward discovering the possibilities of improving the world around them.
- The program features a real world challenge to be solved by research, critical thinking, and imagination.



What will my child do?

- Guided by adult coaches, students will work in teams of six to use LEGO elements to research and build ideas based on the **BOOMTOWN BUILD** challenge theme.
- Students will build a working LEGO model/simple machine and a Show Me poster.
- Teams will present their work at the LEGO League event in December at their school and a district expo.
- More than just playing with LEGOs, students will learn teamwork, problem solving and presentation skills.
