Credit Recovery Courses

Each credit recovery course allows a student to make up one semester of missed credit. Each credit recovery course has a tuition fee of \$150.00.

All courses must be taken in person and attendance is required.

Schedule

Summer Institute runs for 6 weeks, beginning on July 1st, and ending August 8th.

Session 1 runs from 8:00 am-10:10 am

Session 2 runs from 10:20 am-12:30 pm

Classes will be scheduled into sessions based on enrollment.

Available Courses

Each student may enroll in up to two courses.

English

Because of the nature of English classes, students may not take more than one English course per summer.

- English 9 A or B
- English 10 A or B
- English 11 A or B
- English 12 A or B

Math

• All math classes are available during the summer.

Social Studies

- World Studies A or B
- Civics
- Economics
- US History A or B

Science

Science courses will not be offered this summer.

Registration

All payments must be made in full prior to the first day of summer school. Once a student begins a course, no refund will be given. If a course is canceled due to low enrollment, complete payment will be refunded. Students will **not** be provided with bus transportation.

Students will **not** be sent an enrollment confirmation. Please check in the school counseling office if you have further questions.

The last day to register is **June 23, 2025**.

Parents are encouraged to consult their child's teachers during the program for evaluation of their student's work. A grade report will be mailed home at the completion of the program.

Student engagement is essential to be successful in summer school. Attendance is taken each day. Excessive absences may result in failure of the summer school course.
