<p>Options for Students/Families As of 4/19/21</p>	<p>Family choice includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remote Learning (REAL Academy) • Hybrid Learning through the Concurrent Learning Model: Hybrid students have the option of in-person learning 1-5 days per week or Zooming from home 1-5 days per week. 	<p><u>Students are expected to attend school 5 days a week beginning on 4/19, either through Zoom or in person at MMS.</u></p> <p>We encourage you to create a consistent schedule for your student related to the days that they will be attending.</p>
<p>MMS School Schedule</p>	<p>All students will have 4 days per week with Friday as a mini schedule with an Early Release (11:45).</p>	<p>Why abbreviated days on Fridays? 12:00-2:15 Collaboration Time for staff addresses the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Department meetings create consistency in instruction through collaboration with our Remote Staff, Hybrid Staff in the coordination of curriculum related to the Essential Learning Competencies. • Team meetings allow for staff to discuss and determine different ways to support students across the four-core content and unified art teams. • Updating on Canvas pages for students to access assignments, quizzes, resources, videos and timelines for deadlines.
<p>Attendance</p>	<p><u>Remote:</u> (REAL) Process for attendance will not be changing.</p>	<p>If a student is sick and/or unable to attend classes, we need parents to call school and communicate that information.</p>

	<p><u>Hybrid/Concurrent Learning:</u> Students who are physically in MMS will be marked as present. Students who are Zooming in from home will be marked as present with a “W” (Working from Home).</p>	<p>We will be sharing a “How To” instructional video for parents on how to receive push notifications through PowerSchool. This gives instant information to parents regarding whether their student is in school or working from home. Parents of any student not present in one location or the other will receive a phone call.</p>
<p>Maintain Current Mitigation Strategies with some adjustments.</p>	<p><u>Masks:</u> Adherence to the Board Mask Policy without in-school mask breaks <u>Traffic Flow:</u> Adherence to the established traffic flow in the building during passing time. <u>Plexiglass barriers:</u> Plexiglass barriers are being installed in science classrooms and other rooms that have multiple students at one table. <u>Social Distancing:</u> All efforts will be made to provide 3-foot distancing in classrooms.</p>	<p>Mask breaks will be held outside only.</p> <p>Students will have assigned seats in each of their classes.</p> <p>We need students and parents to help with encouraging social distancing and mask wearing to mitigate transmission in and out of school so that we can stay open and safe.</p>
<p>Lunch</p>	<p>State guidelines recommend 6-foot physical distance between students during lunches and snacks.</p> <p>Given these recommendations, we will continue to have students eat lunches in classrooms as well as our two outdoor tents and ½ of the cafeteria.</p>	<p>Fridays: Hybrid students who come into the school building on Fridays can pick up a Grab and Go lunch in the Cafeteria.</p>
