

# Student AM Drop Off

A drop-off area for students is located next to parking lot A. Please refer to the map on the opposite page.

- Turn right into parking lot A
- Follow traffic around parking lot
- Drop student off in designated area
- Exit left at the stop sign and drive down Madeline Bennett Lane to Baboosic Lake Road

Please always use caution. We thank you in advance for your patience and cooperation.

## Tardy/Dismissal Procedures

Drop your child off at the front door if it is after 7:30 AM. You do not need to come into the building.

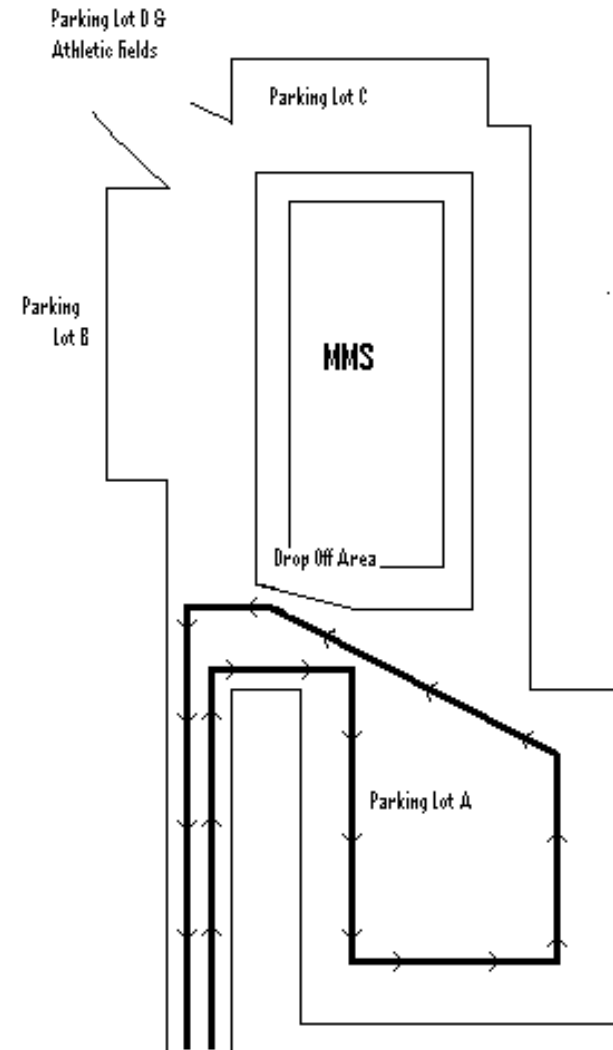
When dismissing your child during the school day or before all the buses have left the premises, you need to come into the building and sign him/her out. Students are not allowed to leave the building unaccompanied before walkers are called.

***Parking or standing on either side of the road in front of the school is prohibited.***

## Walkers and Bikers

Safety is of prime importance. The roads that lead to Merrimack Middle School can be very congested in the morning. Both walkers and riders should use the sidewalk, exercise caution, and follow all safety rules. Walkers and bikers will be dismissed after first and second wave buses have left the middle school property.

Students riding bikes should have locks for their bikes. It is a New Hampshire State Law that bikers under the age of sixteen wear helmets.
