

Merrimack High School Ski and Snowboard Club
2020 Information

The Ski and Snowboard Club is a non-competitive club open to any skiers and snowboarders at MHS. Skiers and snowboarders of all levels are welcome to participate. Lessons and gear rentals are available. This year, we will participate in Crotched Mountain's Voyager Ski and Ride program. Students must be in good behavioral standing with the school in order to participate.

About Crotched Mountain's Voyager Ski and Ride program:

The club will travel together to Crotched Mountain for our five scheduled trips (please see dates below). Then, on February 18, 2020 the pass will convert into an "Explorer Youth Season Pass". This pass will be valid through closing day, with no blackout days, Crotched Mountain and the other mountains in the Peak Resort network.

Dates: 1/9, 1/16, 1/23, 1/30, 2/6. We will leave MHS at 2:30PM and will back to MHS by 9PM. Any sessions we cancel due to a snow day or other weather conditions will be made up in February. Students will not be refunded for sessions they choose to not attend.

Fees:

- Bus: \$60
(All students must take the bus, space is first come first served. Paying the bus fee will reserve you a spot on the bus. Please make checks out to "Merrimack High School". After you submit this payment in person to Mr. Williams, you will receive the login information to Crotched Mountain's website where you will purchase your lift ticket, and lessons and rentals, and all other forms to fill out.)
- Lift ticket: \$129 (Must be purchased online by Friday, November 15, 2019)
- ADD-ON PRODUCTS
 - Lesson Program: add \$70 (5 lessons, beginner through advanced)
 - Equipment Rental Package (5 pack): add \$50
 - Helmet Rental (5 pack): add \$30
 - Seasonal Equipment Rental (to be used at Crotched Mtn. Only, equipment stored at Crotched): \$99
 - Seasonal Equipment Lease (equipment is yours to take and use all season): \$189
 - Students may choose to purchase a Crotched Mountain Youth Season Pass or an Explorer Youth Season Pass through our program.

Policies and procedures:

- All students participating must ride the bus. Students are not allowed to drive themselves.
- Wearing a helmet while skiing or snowboarding on group trips is mandatory.
- You must be present in school on the day of the trip to participate that day.

_____ Purchase your lift ticket/rental/lesson online (this must be completed by Friday, November 15)

_____ Submit the MHS Health Emergency Card and Field Trip Permission (Green card, 2 sided)
