Remote C students Zoom into their classes Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. **Students Zoom into their Homeroom all 4 days.** Friday is a delayed 8 period day schedule (optional) and students check in through Compass on the MHS Homepage.

Hybrid B students Zoom into their classes on Monday and Tuesday and come into the building on Wednesdays and Thursdays. **Homeroom is held all 4 days**. Friday is a delayed 8 period day schedule (optional) and students check in through Compass on the MHS Homepage.

Remote D students Zoom into their classes Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. **Students Zoom into Homeroom all 4 days**. Friday is a delayed 8 period day schedule (optional) and students check in through Compass on the MHS Homepage.

Hybrid Students who are working Remotely with the Same Teachers Zoom into their classes Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. **Students Zoom into Homeroom all 4 days.** Friday is a delayed 8 period day schedule (optional) and students check in through Compass on the MHS

Concurrent Instruction: Hybrid students in the building two days per week for direct instruction, access direct instruction through Zoom the other two days. (For example: Period 1 Group A on Mondays in person while Group B Zooms in and Period 1 Group B on Wednesdays in person while Group A Zooms in/Teacher moves forward with instruction.) Remote students (Cohorts C and D) need to Zoom in both days with their class for direct instruction. Hybrid students at home for a variety of reasons must Zoom in both days of direct instruction. Attendance is mandatory unless the student has been approved for an exception. If the exception is approved, you will see a "Q" indicating principal approved. Students who receive a "W" for attendance are considered PRESENT
