## PARKING/ATTENTION SENIORS AND JUNIORS:

- •SENIORS will be able to obtain their parking permit when they get their ID badges the week of Sept. 1<sup>st</sup>. in the gym, and then through September 18, 2020 in the Main Office. After September 11, there will be an opportunity for the Junior students to obtain a permit. <u>All</u> outstanding financial obligations to MHS must be paid before a parking permit is issued.
- •To obtain a Parking Permit, a student **MUST** show/bring:
  - ✓ His/Her current Merrimack High School ID
  - ✓ His/Her valid New Hampshire driver's license
  - ✓ The Vehicle Registration of the car they will be driving (which must be registered to the student or a family member)
  - ✓A Completed and signed Parking Sticker Application
- •There is no permit fee this year.
- •JUNIORS obtaining permits do so with the understanding that if circumstances change, and MHS returns to an 'all in, non-hybrid' model, there may be a Junior lottery to determine which Juniors retain their permits. The lottery would designate which permits would need to be returned. The lottery would be held only if the number of senior and junior permits exceed the number of allotted student parking spaces. The days, place and times of Junior permit distribution will be announced the first week of school. Juniors may park in student lots until such time that the permit distribution period has finished.
- •Parking permits <u>may</u> be afforded to **SOPHOMORES** after the Senior/Junior process has been finalized, if space allows.
- •AS OF MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 28, 2020 ALL CARS IN THE STUDENT PARKING AREA AT MHS MUST HAVE A CURRENT MHS PARKING PERMIT

**DISPLAYED.** Cars without stickers may be ticketed or towed and this may jeopardize future opportunities for the student to receive a parking permit. Please pay close attention to the areas that are marked for the faculty and those for students. Park only in student designated spaces. If Junior permits have not been distributed, the 9/28 date will be adjusted.
