The Merrimack School Board regrettably announces that Amy Doyle, Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum, Instruction, and Assessment, has resigned from her position effective June 30, 2025, to assume the role of Superintendent of Schools in another district.

Amy has been an integral part of our district's leadership team, contributing significantly to the advancement of our educational programs and the success of our students. Her dedication and expertise have left a lasting impact on our community that will be felt for years to come.

The district is committed to ensuring a smooth transition following her departure. Due to the timing of this change, we will be posting the Assistant Superintendent position on an interim basis for the 2025-2026 school year. This approach will allow us to conduct a comprehensive search for a permanent replacement while maintaining continuity in our curriculum and instructional initiatives.

We extend our heartfelt gratitude to Amy for her service to the Merrimack School District and wish her the very best in her new role.

Further information regarding the interim position and search process will be shared with the community in the coming weeks. At this time, we intend to post for a permanent replacement for the role of Superintendent in November/December 2025, as Bill Olsen's tenure as Chief Education Officer is expected to end on June 30, 2026, and recruit for an Assistant Superintendent beginning in January/February 2026, with an anticipated start date of July 1, 2026 for both positions.
