

- 1. WAIVER: FREE MEALS for all students will be ending in June of this year. All school meals beginning September 2022 will be charged at the 2022-2023 established rate unless you have an approved free and reduced application on file for the prior year or have a new application approved for free and reduced meals prior to the carryover end date (explained below.)
- 2. Free and Reduced carryover grace period to submit a new application for approval will be through 10/17/22. Anyone who does not submit a new application for the 2022-2023 school year or show up on any state report prior to 10/17/22 will automatically move into a paid status on 10/18/22. We tend to experience delays from Health and Humans Services at the beginning of the year. If you apply with a case # for SNAP, TANF, or FDPIR please be sure to circle which program applies to your case #. Please note that NH Health Care case #'s do not qualify for free and reduced lunches; in this case please fill out an application based on your household size and income. Only one application should be submitted per household, all students can be listed on the same application regardless of what school they are attending. If you would like to check your status come the end of September feel free to e-mail foodservice@sau26.org to see if a new application is required. If you think you may qualify for free and reduced meals it would be advisable to submit one as soon as possible this year to get you through the 30-day carryover at the beginning of the next school year.
- 3. **KITCHEN WORKERS NEEDED:** Great part time work during the school day that follows the school calendar. Most shifts are 4 hours. You can apply online at the district website. Subs also needed for even more flexibility.
