

ADVANCED COLLEGE PLACEMENT

Any student who is capable of, and wishes to do, college-level work while in high school shall be given assistance in enrolling in advanced courses. Though some courses require a prerequisite, this should not discourage students from seeking the advice of their counselors and teachers in taking a course where they may not have the prerequisite, but have an interest and feel they can be successful.

Any student whose admission to a college-level course is recommended by his/her counselor may enroll in a course at an approved college for college credit, at no cost to the District. If the student wishes to receive high school credit for the course, he/she may request permission from the Academic Review Board, through the principal, to apply the course toward high school graduation requirements.
