

ASSIGNMENT OF STUDENTS TO CLASSES AND GRADE LEVELS

Students will be enrolled in grades and classes in which they can be expected to meet established district instructional and learning objectives. All students who are included under the compulsory attendance law must be enrolled and required to attend all classes prescribed by the state and the district unless exempt by the school authorities.

Students will be placed in the grade level and class that best meets the student's academic needs. Students transferring into the school district will be placed in the grade level and class that best meets the student's needs, after review of the records from the student's prior school. Students receiving special education services will be placed in accordance with applicable law.

The decision of the building principal regarding student placement may be appealed to the Superintendent, and then to the School Board. The School Board will give significant consideration to the principal's and Superintendent's recommended placement.
