An asterisk (*) at hen end of line items the budget texts represents items cut from the 2016-2017 budget that have been reintroduced to the 2017 -2018 budget.

Regarding new texts, the following are requested:

• The Social Studies department is requesting additional World Studies texts to support freshmen curricula;

Regarding additional equipment, the following items are requested:

- The Math department is requesting six (6) graphing calculator packs and mini, hand-held whiteboards.
- The Science department requests six (6) oxygen probes, eight (8) dissecting microscopes, and one (1) mounted camera for microscopes.
- The Athletic department requests forty (40) certified lacrosse helmets consistent with concussion protocols to ensure the safety of our student-athletes.

Regarding replacement line items, the following items are requested:

- One (1) cafeteria table, twelve (12) student chairs, twelve (8) desk combos, and four (8) computer lab tables.
- The Technical Education department requests seven (7) editing workstations, two (2) cameras, and one (1) wood lathe.

Regarding athletic equipment, the following replacement items are requested:

• Twenty (20) shoulder pads, fifteen (15) football helmets, one (1) football blocking sled, and one (1) pair of volleyball poles with nets.
