The increase in the Science Text account is due to the purchase of an online subscription, which will serve to support the integration of science and reading instruction in grades 1-4.

The Classroom, Computer, and Health Supply accounts reflect a slight per pupil increase due to the addition of a new preschool program.

Lastly, the furniture replacement account reflects the cost of items deferred in the 2016-2017 budget.
